To protect our research and development outcomes, maintain innovation capabilities, strengthen competitive advantages, enhance corporate profitability, achieve operational goals, and implement corporate governance, our company has developed an intellectual property (IP) strategy that aligns with our business objectives and R&D resources. We have established a “Patent Application Reward Program” to encourage employees to submit invention applications. Patent applications are integrated with customer needs, company operational strategies, and IP strategies, forming a business management model that enhances the use of intellectual property. This approach will strengthen the application of intellectual property, improve corporate competitiveness, and reduce infringement risks, ultimately safeguarding the maximum value and interest of the company and its shareholders.

Intellectual Property Protection Measures

- Patents
 - Regular Patent Monitoring:
We actively monitor recent patent approvals in the industry to understand market trends. We have also appointed Liyang International Patent and Trademark Office to assist with managing our patents and trademarks.
 - Regular Maintenance and Review:
We regularly review the use of granted patents and their relevance to our products to evaluate the need for ongoing maintenance.
 - Patent Awareness Campaign:
We aim to strengthen employees' understanding of patents and respect for patent rights, ensuring awareness of the legal boundaries in product development.
- Trademarks
 - Regular Maintenance and Review:
We review the usage of registered trademarks to assess whether they need continued maintenance. Additionally, we closely monitor the company's future development plans and apply for trademark registrations in advance.
- Trade Secrets
 - Information Security Management:
All of our computer systems require employees to log in with personal account passwords, which must be changed periodically.
 - Confidentiality Awareness Campaign:
We ensure that all employees are aware of trade secrets and promote the establishment of a legal awareness culture.

Execution Results

Starting in 2024, our company will regularly report intellectual property matters to the board of directors in the fourth quarter of each year. The most recent report was presented on December 11, 2025, during the 12th board meeting of the 8th session.

Intellectual Property List and Results

- Patents

As of the end of 2025, the company has obtained a total of over 210 patents worldwide, with 139 granted registrations. Currently, 116 patents remain in force, including 11 in Taiwan, 19 in China, 85 in the United States, 1 in the European Union, 1 in Japan, and 1 in Korea.

- Trademarks

As of the end of 2025, the company held 21 trademarks, primarily registered in Taiwan, South Korea, and mainland China.
